Therefore, Oxford Seniors of 2020 will always be grateful for the opportunity granted by their beloved School as every moment that passed will forever be in our hearts and memories.

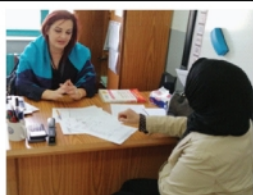
